These different units allow both the operators and owners to carry out many more functions within their business. Choosing the right type of crane is crucial for making certain that the material could be moved safely and efficiently to the place it has to get to in order for the construction process to start. Truck cranes would usually have 2 different cabs. One cab is used to drive the truck unit when in transport mode, while the other is for controlling the crane. These cranes are very useful for building locations where a crane is needed in many different locations for the duration of the build. This is because of the fact that the crane could be driven easily from one place to another. Moreover, the cranes could be transported to various construction sites on the road since they could drive themselves and this eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own really reduces transport expenses at the end of the day. The truck crane however is not stable enough to handle all the major loads which a hydraulic crane could handle. Thus, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers could be extended from the deck. The outriggers utilize hydraulic pressure in order to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it stable and balanced. Crawler cranes feature big tracks on the bottom of the crane. These huge tracks are similar to the ones seen on other construction machinery such as backhoes and bulldozers. The tracks allow the crane to move around a construction site successfully.
